

Malden Fire Service – Historical Information

The Malden Fire Service was established in 1947. Their first fire truck was a Bickle-Seagrave purchased on April 10, 1947. Back then, the Malden Fire Service's team consisted of 7 Firefighters and the Chief. Norman Mickle was the Fire Chief and his salary was \$100 per year. The Firefighters were paid \$2 per practice and \$3 per call. During the Malden Fire Service's first 30 years, the team responded to 600 calls.
